The Professional Organizational Development Program is designed primarily for adults with some college credit or with a college transfer associate of arts or associate of science degree. Through this program, students will attend classes on Monday nights and do additional online work to complete as many as 12 credit hours of work per semester. If other requirements are necessary for graduation, these courses will also be offered in the evenings or fully online. The 48-hour major can be completed in as little as four semesters.
