State-by-state general disclosures are required by 34 CFR 668.43(5)(v) for academic programs designed to meet educational requirements for a specific professional license or certification that is required for

employment in an occupation, or is advertised as meeting such requirements. These disclosures refer only to educational requirements, and there may be other requirements, in addition to education, that must be met in order to qualify for licensure (e.g. sit for an exam, years of work experience, etc.)

North Carolina participates in an interstate agreement managed through the National Association of State Directors of Teacher Education and Certification (NASDTEC). As such, candidates earning a NC professional teaching license may be able to reciprocate this license to to other specified states (a list of approved states is below). Reciprocity applies to the extent that out-of-state education programs are equivalent to standards and guidelines of North Carolina's approved education programs. Reciprocity does not guarantee that all areas of licensure will transfer directly from one state to another, and you may be awarded the closest comparable North Carolina areas.
