

ABOUT LENOIR-RHYNE

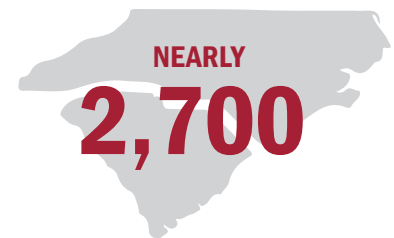


Founded in 1891, Lenoir-Rhyne University is a co-educational, private liberal arts institution with 50 undergraduate degree programs and nearly 30 graduate degree programs. With a 13:1 student-to-faculty ratio, LR enrolls nearly 2,700 undergraduate and graduate students. Additionally, LR awards more than \$30+ million in merit scholarships, and nearly 99 percent of our students are awarded financial aid. LR fosters a positive learning environment at its three locations including its main campus in Hickory, North Carolina; the Center for Graduate Studies of Asheville, North Carolina; as well as the Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary and the Center for Graduate Studies of Columbia, South Carolina.

LEARN HOW LR MAKES ACCESS TO A COLLEGE DEGREE MORE AFFORDABLE

Upon review of your FAFSA, the Lenoir-Rhyne Promise, lr.edu/lr-promise, is a guaranteed financial aid package worth at least half the value of tuition for full-time undergraduate first-year and transfer students who meet the following requirements at time of admittance:

- Resident of North Carolina (at time of admittance)
- 3.5 or higher high school GPA for first year students
- 3.5 or higher college GPA and 30 earned credit hours

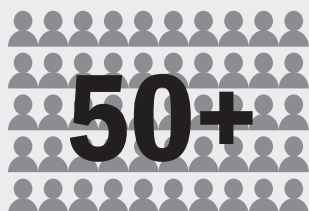
LR BY THE NUMBERS

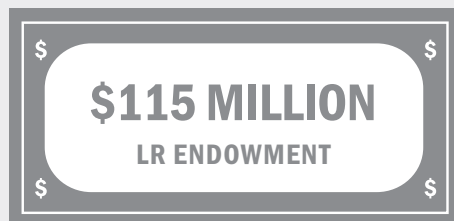
