

Lenoir-Rhyne Summer Youth Music Camp Behavior Contract and Camper Code of Conduct

The staff and faculty of LRSYM are committed to providing a safe and enjoyable experience for your child; however, campers are also responsible for assisting in these efforts. Parents/guardians are responsible to ensure their child understands the guidelines below.

Our Code of Conduct is based on the principle of respect:

- Campers will show respect to other participants and treat others as they would like to be treated.
- Campers will show respect to staff and faculty and cooperate fully with their instructions.
- Campers will respect the rights and beliefs of others, treating others with courtesy and consideration.
- Campers will respect the unique differences and abilities of each camper.
- Campers will respect the property of others, including campus equipment, classrooms, and the environment.
- Campers will conduct themselves responsibly and respectfully.

All campers are expected to:

- attend each day in its entirety.
- be attentive and participate to their best ability.
- remain on the Lenoir-Rhyne University campus during camp hours (even during break times).
- follow all of their school's guidelines in regard to conduct (including tobacco and other prohibited substances, etc.)
- pay attention to their surroundings and use care in all activities.
- adhere to all safety rules and regulations given for each activity.
- wear appropriate clothing and shoes.
- inform staff if they are experiencing a problem.

If the Code of Conduct is not followed, a verbal warning will be given. After one warning, the Camp Director will be notified, as well as parents as appropriate. Serious infractions that impact camper safety and well-being may result in immediate dismissal from camp.

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Parents agree to provide immediate assistance in the event that LRSYM staff request help dealing with student behavior problems.
